

CPA Manitoba's In-Person Event Policy

As we transition back to in-person events, CPA Manitoba has the health and safety of our members, guests and staff at the forefront. We commit to following all of the Province of Manitoba's public health orders and recommendations. We ask that our event attendees are committed to doing the same.

Monitoring of Symptoms

If you are feeling unwell or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 within 3 days prior to the event, we request that you notify events@cpamb.ca to cancel your registration.

Masks

Masks have proven to be an effective measure for limiting the spread of illness. While masks are not mandatory at our events, we recommend the usage of them while moving around event venues. Masks would not be recommended while seated. CPA Manitoba will have a supply of masks available at events if you would like one.

Sanitizing

Hand sanitizer will be available at the event venues and we recommend sanitizing upon check-in.

Networking

CPA Manitoba recognizes that in-person event attendees will have varying levels of comfort while networking. Please take a moment to ask for consent before going in for a handshake, hug, or elbow bump.

COVID-19 Immunization

Effective March 1, 2022, the Province of Manitoba no longer requires proof of vaccination to attend event venues. As such, we will not require attendees to provide this during check-in.

Cancellation

If you need to cancel your attendance for an in-person event due to illness, CPA Manitoba commits to offering a full refund.
